

**PORT ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW SYSTEM  
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY OF THE PORT OF CIVITAVECCHIA**

In accordance with art. 6, item 1, of Law no. 84, dated January 28, 1994, the Civitavecchia Port Authority (C.P.A.), directs, coordinates, promotes and supervises port operations and other commercial and industrial activities which are performed in the port of Civitavecchia with the power to issue rules and ordinances. C.P.A. manages the state maritime properties, undertakes important state-funded port infrastructure and guarantees routine and emergency maintenance of public areas.

C.P.A. has established, as one of its main objectives, the decrease of the environmental effects of port activities through the adoption of an Environmental Management System, in compliance with the Port Environmental Review System developed by European Sea Ports Organisation.

The objectives pursued through the continuous improvement of the Environmental Management System, with a precise responsibility to prevent pollution and to comply with environmental regulations, through the participation of all employees, are:

- the creation of an Ethics and Scientific Committee, to support the management of social and ethical risks related to port operations;
- compliance with current EU, State, Regional and local law systems and also with requirements and rules voluntarily signed by C.P.A., that improve provisions of current regulation;
- continual improvement of the environmental performance of concessionaires and port operators, by issuing specific rules, as provided by Law no. 84 dated January 28, 1994. The above-mentioned objective is reached by investments in new knowledge and technology, increasing cooperation between different Port Administrations to make it easier to implement the environmental practices and to share the costs of the environmental solutions identified;
- prevention of pollution within the port area;
- to act as advocate of environmental conservation between port Administrations;
- awareness-raising and training of all staff working for or on behalf of the Civitavecchia Port Authority in environmental issues, thereby involving them in the implementation of the Environmental Management System;
- to make public the environmental policy, publishing it in the environmental section of the Port Authority's website;
- promotion of an efficient use of energy and, more generally, of all natural resources for port activities;
- use of best practices and technology during construction, management and maintenance of port infrastructure, aimed at decreasing their environmental impacts
- continual analysis of the major environmental impacts of port activities, including establishing plans to monitor their impacts;
- adoption of "green public procurement" policies supporting suppliers operating in compliance with sound environmental practices;
- support and participation in monitoring and research activities aimed at reducing the impacts of port operations and traffic;
- improvement of ship waste management in the port of Civitavecchia.

For the achievement of these objectives, Civitavecchia Port Authority undertakes to implement the Environmental Management System, in compliance with E.S.P.O. and with its guidance documents, in order to maintain legislative compliance in all fields of interest, and to ensure the continuous improvement of its environmental performances.
